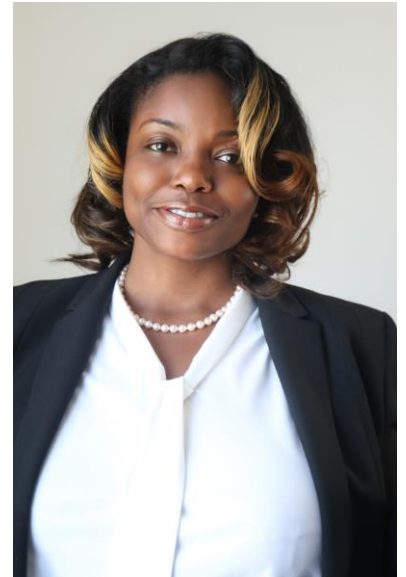


Sharee McCall
